Sustainability: From Cost to Profit A forum with Italian and US experts



Organized by Istituto Italiano di Cultura in New York and La Voce di New York on the occasion of the 5th Edition of the Sustainable Development Festival promoted by Alleanza Italiana per lo Sviluppo Sostenibile (ASviS) and in view of COP26.



The Forum will address the issue of sustainability in its various aspects: financial and productive, economic and ecological, cultural and social.

The discussion will explore the topic of sustainability from a double perspective:

- a) from being perceived as a cost, sustainability must become a growth factor.
- b) sustainability should be nurtured not only on the field of environment and ecology, but also society, art and culture.

The discussion will focus on the best practices of sustainability connecting several dimensions: economic, cultural, social, scientific, technological. The forum will promote a dialogue between journalists, economists, companies, scientists, intellectuals, and young leaders belonging to Italy, Europe and the United States.

In parallel with the Forum, the Italian Cultural Institute will host an exhibition on sustainable fabrics by Italian fashion houses (12-26 October).
